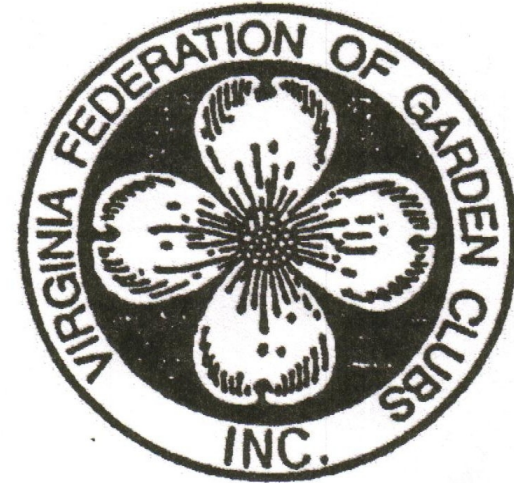
### **Laurie Fox, Ph.D.**
